GEORGIAN GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP - 2018

The Department of Adult and Higher Education, Ministry of Education is pleased to inform that the Georgian Government has offered **one** scholarship at the Tbilisi State Medical University, Georgia in the medical programs offered by the university.

Therefore, interested 2017 BHSEC (class XII) cohort of students (*except already selected for 2018 in-country and ex-country scholarships*) with **minimum of 65% each in Physics, Chemistry and Biology with 55 % in English** may apply for the slot.

Given below are the terms and conditions of the Scholarship:

1. Applicants should have no penal records or no major health problems.
2. It is a total tuition free (100% tuition fee waiver) scholarship.
3. Monthly stipend of 720 Georgian Lari will be paid.
4. Travel expenses (airfare for both to and fro) and any other miscellaneous costs should be borne by the individual(s) concerned.

Candidates fulfilling the above mentioned criteria are advised to apply/register on-line using the prescribed Application Form available at <https://www.citizenservices.gov.bt/education-services> and follow the link "Application for Scholarship" on or before **25th May 2018**.

For online application/registration, the following documents must be ready:

- Online approved valid security clearance
- Scanned copy of class X mark sheet (**front page only**) for upload
- Bhutanese Citizenship Identity Card
- Index number of BHSEC (2017)

Please note that repeaters and those already selected for any in-country/ex-country scholarships 2018 are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply. The Ministry of Education will select the candidates based on academic merit and forward the nominations to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Thimphu for onward submission to the Georgian Embassy in Delhi.

Visa Proceeding:	Information on applying for the Georgian visa will be provided additionally. <u>Mandatory International Travel Insurance during trip to Georgia is required</u>
Medical Insurance:	It is mandatory to become a member of the local insurance scheme of the University (package cost varies from 7 to 25 USD per month according to student's preference), unless student is covered by the international medical insurance. Insurance expenses will be deducted from the provided monthly stipend.
Accommodation:	<p>TSMU currently has no dormitory. Students can rent accommodation facilities nearby the Medical University (guidance will be provided by the University). Accommodation expenses should be covered from the monthly stipend.</p> <p>The University can arrange the hostel accommodation (around 15 USD per night with breakfast included) during the first 3-5 days after arrival in Tbilisi. The hostel expenses are to be borne by the students themselves.</p>
What to bring:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The students are advised that it will probably take several days before receiving their first stipend. Therefore, it is recommended that the students bring some money in cash (at least 200 USD) for their personal expenditures. 2. Clothes for all seasons. Georgia has four seasons. January-February are the coldest months in Tbilisi with a temperature range from -3°C to 7°C. In October the average temperature varies between 13-22°C. July-August are the hottest months with a temperature range from 25°C up to 40°C. Please, check the weather in Tbilisi before departure for Georgia. If desired, students can shop for winter cloths in Georgia for more affordable prices than in tropical countries (<u>www.meteo.gov.ge</u>).
