Dear Lyompo Norbu Wangchuk,

I am writing to you today to tell you that the University of New Brunswick is very pleased to announce that starting in September, 2016, UNB shall provide a bursary to offset foreign student differential fees for up to ten (10) candidates per year for Bhutanese students starting a degree program. This arrangement will be available to students between 2016 and 2020. UNB will not be responsible for travel, accommodation or other expenses beyond the foreign student differential stees.

The University of New Brunswick will accept Bhutanese students into UNB undergraduate programs on a first come first serve basis for applicants who meet the entrance qualifications for their selected degrees. Students must maintain passing grades to ensure continued foreign fee waiver. Each student will be eligible for up to five years of this fee differential.

We believe this process will strengthen the long term partnership and commitment that that University of New Brunswick has held with the Royal Government of Bhutan since 1985 and look forward to many more Bhutanese students coming to Fredericton or Saint John to work with us for their studies.
